



Aditya Puri – The Visionary Banker



The candidates may apply via online mode from 11.04.2025 to 24.05.2025 at www.hpuiv.ac.in. The eligibility criterion is graduation in any discipline from a recognized university with 50% marks (45% for SC/ST candidates). The candidates appearing in graduation final year examination can also apply. The HPU- MAT will be conducted at Shimla, Solan, Dharamshala, Hamirpur, Mandi, Una, Palampur and Nalagarh. However, H.P. University reserves the right to cancel any center at any time. The date of HPU-MAT Entrance Examination will be 10.06.2025.
