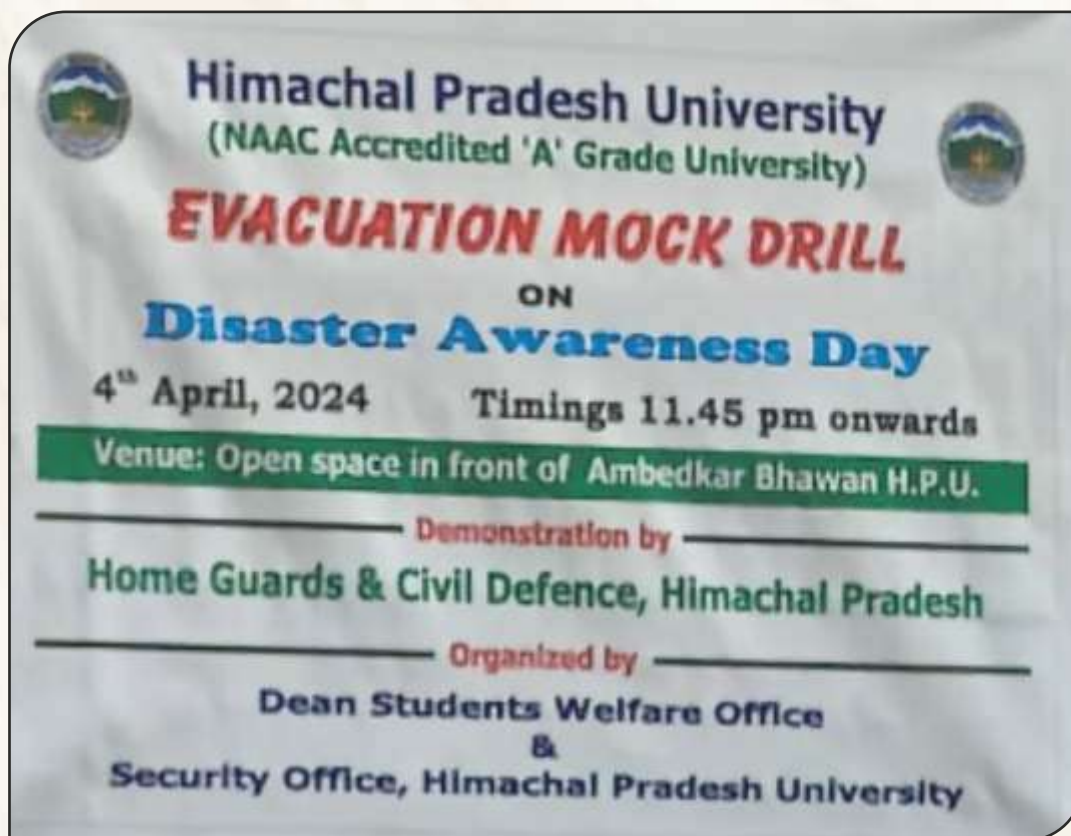




## MOCK DRILL ON DISASTER AWARENESS DAY WAS ORGANISED

## **CAMPAIGN ON SUBSTANCE USE PREVENTION ORGANISED ON 3RD AUGUST, 2024**

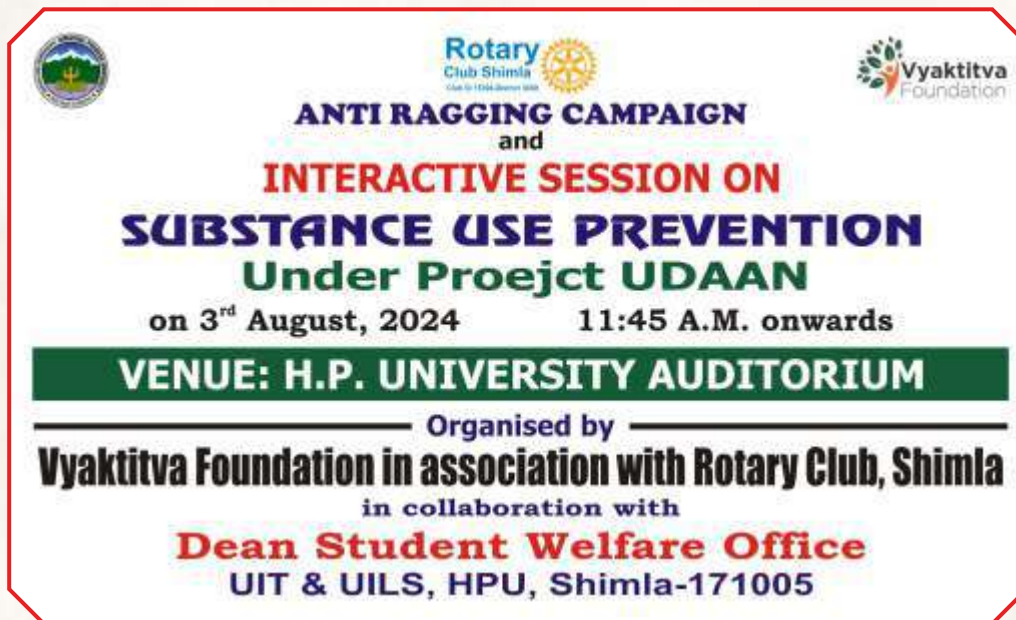

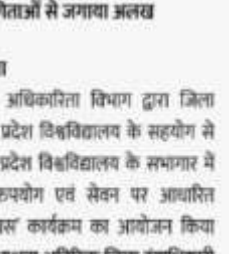
