Subject: To implement the directions issued by the Standing Committee/Academic Council qua distribution of 100 marks for theory vis-à-vis Internal Assessment (Assignment only) for the students enrolled for B.A. degree with Mathematics as an Elective Subject through Open and Distance Learning mode (ODL) in ICDEOL at par with all the UG Degrees with Elective/Discipline Specific subjects run through regular mode in Degree Colleges affiliated with H. P. University w.e.f. the Academic Session 2018-2019 onwards.

In this meeting:

The letters No.ICDEOL/23-4/2014-15/HPU/Admn., dated 30.03.2019 (Annexure-B) addressed to the Dean, Faculty of Physical Sciences by the Director ICDEOL and No.1-10/2019-HPU(DS)-1048, dated 13.08.2019 (Annexure-C) addressed to the Dean, Faculty of Physical Sciences by the Dean of Studies on the above cited subject were placed before the Members of Board of Studies (UG) in the subject of Mathematics. The Members discussed these letters in detail.

Further, the directions and guidelines issued by the UGC vide Notification No.2-4/2015(DEB-III), dated 23.06.2017 (Annexure-A) published in the Gazette of India the provision of evaluation and certification vide Sr. No. 13(2) & 13(6), issuing the guidelines for home assignments for the students enrolled through Open and Distance Learning Mode (ODL) mode were also discussed and deliberated by the Members pertaining to the above mentioned subject/courses. In views of the above guidelines and the letters, the Members of Board of Studies (UG) in the subject of Mathematics, unanimously decided the following:

1. For Courses without Practicals:

The following scheme of Annual Examinations (AE) and Internal Assessment (IA) for three years UG Degree Courses with Mathematics as an Elective Subject for ICDEOL students only, w.e.f. academic session 2018-2019 enwards:

a) Theory Papers (Annual Examinations (AE);

70 marks

b) Internal Assessment in the form of Home Assignments (*)

30 marks

(*) The students must answer at lest 75% of the assignments sent to them to become eligible to appear in the annual examinations.

NOTE: The minimum pass percentage will be 40% (Both Annual Examinations and Internal Assessment Separately.

1. For Courses with Practical:

a) Theory Papers (Annual Examinations (AE):

50 Marks

b) Internal Assessment (IA) in the form of House Assignments (**)

30 Marks

c) Practical

20 Marks

(**) The students have to answer at least 75% of the Home Assignments sent to them become eligible to appear in the Annual Examinations.

NOTE: The minimum pass percentage in each component (Annual Examination, Internal Assessment and Practical shall be 40% separately).

The syllabus and its other contents will remain the same as already approved by
