Meeting Agenda: Following items were taken for discussion and deliberations:

Item No. I Approval of the syllabus of M.A. and M.Phil in Political Science Courses.

The Chairperson of the Department of Political Science HPU Shimla convened an online meeting on Google meet regarding P.G. Board of Studies as per the university notification no. 1-24/76-HPU (Genl.) dated 10th July 2020. After long deliberations which involved all the teaching faculty members, and the Board of Studies members with two external subject experts, it was unanimously resolved:

The members decided that M.A. in Political Science will comprise of four semesters and sixteen courses. In each semester there will be four courses and the courses of first and second semester will be compulsory. There will be one optional paper with three choices in third and fourth semesters. A student shall have to secure at least 36% marks in each paper (theory as well as internal assessment) to qualify the examination. The pattern of examination shall be as under:

For Regular Students: Theory- 80; Internal Assessment- (Assignments 10, Attendance 05 & Presentation 05) = 20


For ICDEOL students: Theory 80, Internal Assessment (Assignments) = 20

For Private students: Theory 100 Marks
(Detailed syllabus and guidelines as per Annexure I).


- (2) The members also decided that M. Phil in Political Science will consist of two papers of 100 marks each in 1st Semester. In addition of these two papers there will be 100 marks for dissertation and Viva-Voce. Out of which 75 marks will be allotted to the evaluation of the Dissertation and 25 marks for Viva-Voce. (Detailed syllabus and guidelines as per Annexure II).


The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the external experts and the members of the Board of Studies.






