



#### **EDITORIAL LEARNING**

#### **INTRA-COMMUNICATION: THE HIDDEN ASPECTS**

Intra-communication is often ignored while concentrating on communication. The reality is that self preparedness is much more important for communicating. The communicator is sometimes not interested to communicate due to psychological or other reasons concerning gratification. One important aspect of understanding preparedness of a person to communicate or to listen is related with the hidden aspect of intra-communicational characteristics which consist of mainly two types of settings:

## 1. The Psycho-organic Settings:

The psycho-organic settings include such a system of the human body of the individual person which is related to the organic system involved in the process of communication. It is responsible for determining the degree of accuracy and efficiency of Intra-communication. In this category, individual person may have the characteristics of fast communicational skill, slow, person communicating in distortions due to psycho-organic barriers interrupting to pass messages with accuracy and efficiency within own self.

# 2. Behavioral Settings:

The behavioral settings are more dominant amongst all. Human behavior is actually the reflection of different forms of Intracommunicational characteristics like cleverness, strictness, promptness, slow, aggressive, gentle etc. these characteristics are sometimes determinants of developing impression within self of the individual person regarding others. Such characteristics and the hidden impression responsible for developing of such characteristics determine human behavior as well as the accuracy and efficiency of intra-communication which later-on proceeds in different forms of communication.

For effective communication, it is pertinent to understand and improve such intra-communicational hidden aspects.
