EDITORIAL LEARNING

ETHICS IN DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES

Ethics in common parlance is understood in terms of deeds and behavior. Deeds when are talked about, are good and bad deeds. Good deeds of a person or group in a specified social set-up are such which are acceptable by that social set-up. So good or bad deeds are dependent upon acceptance by the related social set-up. Good deed for a social strata may be bad deeds for the other one. It is subjective and dependent upon the society. However, the broader perspective of ethics is what is stated in the philosophy or epics and is accepted by all. It is a phenomenon of common acceptance. In context to sub-social systems, sectors, culture or micro levels in practicality, the connotation of ethics are defined in terms of the norms, culture, values, environmental conditions, organizational or social structure, motive, tradition and many other criteria. Ethics can- not be considered as a generalized concept in practicality though its overall impact is generalized and based upon the culture and value system in accordance to the philosophy. Organizational people have the ethical standards based upon the organizational norms and philosophy. Academic and research institutions have their own ethics. Adhering to the ethics in the specific environment leads to maintain discipline and growth. Even geographical conditions define the code of ethics of the different regions. It can be stated that the perspective of ethics has diverse connotations depending upon the conditions, situations and criteria but are mandatory to follow to be part of the system.
