Note:

- **A)** Course Code Description: The codes for the three types of courses on offer are as follows:
 - 1. Discipline Specific Core Courses (DSC), e.g. MSKTC-101
 - 2. Discipline Specific Elective Courses (DSE) e.g. MSKTE-304
 - **3.** Generic Elective (GE) e.g. MSKTG-205 (i))

Here: M denotes Master of Arts; SKT denotes Sanskrit; C denotes Compulsory Course; E denotes Elective, G denotes Generic Elective; the digits 101, 1-represents 1st semester, 0-represents code and 1-represents 1st course. Similarly, 304, 3-represents 3rd Semester, 0-represents code and 4-represents 4th Course and 205 (1), 2-represents 2nd Semester, 0-represents code and 5 represents 5th Course (Optional Course number one).

B) Regarding DSE Courses

- 1. Semester III: One course is to be opted from courses-DSE-I and DSE-II.
- 2. Semester IV: One course is to be opted from courses-DSE-III and DSE-IV.
- 3. In case of regular students, the Department will offer only one Elective Course in Semesters III and IV. A second Elective Course will be offered only if there are minimum 05 students opting for the same and will further depend upon the availability of faculty.

C) Regarding GE Courses

1. In case of regular students, each student will take two Generic Elective Courses, one each in Semesters II and IV, in any other discipline/department. One Generic Elective Course offered in the II and IV semesters respectively of the M.A. Programme in the subject of Sanskrit will be open as an interdisciplinary Course to all full-time students registered in any regular master's programme of the University. The total number of such students accepted in each semester will be equal to the student strength in respective semester of M.A. Sanskrit programme.

D) General Information

1. Number of seats, eligibility, basis of admission, age limit, reservation, fee structure, scheme of examination and qualifying marks will be as per the University rules as prescribed in the Himachal Pradesh University Ordinance and Handbook of Information from time to time.

II Scheme of Courses: Three Categories of Courses are as follows:

- 1. Discipline Specific Core Compulsory Courses (14 Core Courses; {Core})
- 2. Discipline Specific Elective Courses (2 Elective Courses; {DSE})
- 3. Generic Elective Courses (2 Generic Elective; {GE})

A student is required to complete **four** Core Courses each in Semesters I and II, and **three** Core Courses, **one** Elective Course and **one** Generic Elective (GE) each in Semesters II and IV.

III Scheme of Examination

Each Course shall be of 100 marks and qualifying marks in each Course shall be 40 marks.

i) For **regular students**, the distribution of 100 marks shall be 80 for Theory and 20 for Internal Assessment. The Internal Assessment of 20 marks shall comprise of: Attendance = 5marks, Assignments/ Presentation = 5 marks, Internal Examinations = 10 marks.

Marks for attendance is given as per the following criterion:

75% to 80% : 1 Mark 81% to 85% : 2 Marks 86% to 90% : 3 Marks 91% to 95% : 4 Marks 96% to 100% : 5 Marks

- ii) In case of students of Distance Education, i.e., **ICDEOL**, the distribution of 100 marks shall be 80 for Theory and 20 for Internal Assessment. This Internal Assessment of 20 marks shall be based on compulsory assignments submitted by the students in each Course in each Semester.
- iii) In case of **Private Students**, each Course shall be of 100 marks and there will be no internal assessment/compulsory assignments.
- iv) The syllabus for each course comprise of 4 sections with five units.

Pattern of Testing:

Compulsory question consists of 08 short answer questions of 2 marks each, i.e., total 16 marks. Four long answers questions carry 16 marks per unit, i.e., total 64 marks.
