The Committee further recommended that:

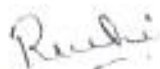
1. A comprehensive and learner-centric academic framework be devised to facilitate a seamless transition to the semester system, keeping in view the distinctive requirements of distance learners.
2. The existing examination and evaluation regulations be suitably revised to incorporate continuous and comprehensive assessment, including assignments, internal evaluation, and term-end examinations in a balanced manner.

3. The Personal Contact Programme (PCP) be suitably restructured and strengthened to align with the semester pattern, ensuring adequate academic support and engagement within a shorter academic cycle.
4. A robust Learning Management System (LMS) be developed and effectively utilised for the dissemination of study material, conduct of academic interactions, and monitoring of learner progress.
5. Orientation and capacity-building programmes be organised for faculty members, academic counsellors, and administrative staff to ensure effective implementation of the revised system.
6. Clear academic calendars and guidelines be formulated and communicated well in advance to ensure clarity, transparency, and timely completion of all academic activities.
7. The transition be undertaken in a phased and carefully monitored manner so as to maintain academic standards and minimise disruption to learners.

Proceedings of the Grievance Redressal Mechanism Committee

Dated: 20.04.2026

In continuation of the previous meeting of the Committee, a meeting of the Grievance Redressal Mechanism Committee was convened under the Chairmanship of Dr. Shashi Kant Sharma in Room No. 202 to deliberate upon matters pertaining to the refinement and strengthening of the grievance redressal portal.

At the outset, the Chair extended a cordial welcome to all members of the Committee present and briefly apprised them of the proceedings of the previous meeting.

Agenda:

1. The Committee deliberated upon the proposal that additional tabs namely 'Action Taken', 'Remarks', and 'Student Feedback' be incorporated into the grievance redressal portal to enhance transparency and accountability.
2. To consider the establishment of a clearly defined timeline and escalation mechanism for the prompt and effective disposal of grievances.
3. To examine the integration of an automated notification system (SMS/e-mail alerts) to keep stakeholders informed at each stage of grievance redressal.

Resolution:

After due deliberations, the Committee unanimously resolved to approve, in principle, the incorporation of additional functional tabs in the grievance redressal portal, namely 'Action Taken', 'Remarks', and 'Student Feedback', with a view to ensuring greater transparency, accountability, and user engagement. It was further resolved that a structured timeline along with an appropriate escalation mechanism be instituted for the timely redressal of grievances, and that an automated notification system be integrated to provide real-time updates to stakeholders, subject to technical feasibility and approval of the competent authority.



Recommendations:

The Committee further recommended that:

1. A standardised framework be developed outlining categories of grievances, designated authorities, and stipulated timelines for each stage of redressal.
2. The portal be designed with a user-friendly interface, ensuring ease of access, clarity of information, and accessibility for all stakeholders, including distance learners.
3. Periodic monitoring and review mechanisms be instituted to assess the efficiency and responsiveness of the grievance redressal system.
4. Adequate training and orientation be provided to the concerned staff for the effective handling and timely resolution of grievances.

At the outset, the Director, CDOE welcomed all the members present in the meeting and asked the Chairman of the Committee to discuss the agenda of the meeting. The Chairman, Human Resource and Infrastructural committee revealed that it is necessary to comply with the guidelines issued in the UGC DEB Regulations, 2020 with regard to human resource and infrastructure. After due deliberations, following decisions were taken in the meeting:-

The Committee apprised about the UGC DEB Regulation 2020 with regard to faculty position that as per regulation at least three faculty members (full-time dedicated) are required for running Under Graduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) programme in same discipline and two faculty members are required for running per UG or PG Course. At present, there is shortage of faculty in some courses like History, Commerce, Sanskrit, Journalism, Sociology and Music.



2. The Committee after due deliberation on the matter apprised that 02 posts in the subject of History, 02 posts in the subject of Commerce, 02 posts in the subject of Sanskrit, 02 posts in the subject of Journalism, 02 posts in the subject of Sociology, and 03 posts in the subject of Music are required and matter may be place for further action.
3. It is observed by the committee that in pursuance to the physical infrastructure, the following provision are required for conducive environment:
- (i) More class rooms for ODL students need to be established.
 - (ii) Computer Lab and existing computers with faculty need an up gradation with adequate number of computers and latest software.
 - (iii) Conference hall dedicated to ODL students need to be established.
 - (iv) Latest technology computer systems may be provided to all the faculty members of CDOE.
 - (v) Library should be digitized.
 - (vi) Hostel building of CDOE should be renovated as soon as possible so that space can be utilized to facilitate the students.

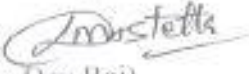

The deliberations were mainly focused on the issue of the territorial jurisdiction of CDOE/ICDEOL, consequent upon the establishment of Sardar Patel University, Mandi. The following points were emerged:

1. The committee discussed that in pursuance to the notification No. EDN-A-Ka(s)-22/2023 dated 12th January, 2023, regarding territorial jurisdiction, the examination centre for CDOE students are being created in all 12 districts of the State to conduct examinations, in respect of students enrolled in various Under-Graduate, Post-Graduate and Diploma Courses run through ODL mode.
2. The Committee suggested that the students enrolled in various courses run through CDOE belongs to far flung areas of the state, therefore in order to facilitate them, Personal Contact Programmes (PCP) should be conducted in blended mode at Learner Support Centres as well as at Headquarter.
3. The H.P. University has created sufficient examination centres for the academic session 2026-27 in respect of postgraduate classes for CDOE students in district Mandi, Kullu and LahaulSpiti which comes under the purview of Sardar Patel University, Mandi. Accordingly, sufficient examination centre may be created for under graduate students of CDOE also.

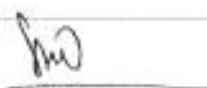
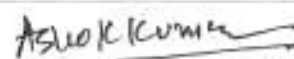

PROCEEDING OF THE COMMITTEE HELD ON IMPROVEMENT STRATEGIES AS PER UGC DEB REGULATIONS 2020 GUIDELINES FOR ICDEOL'S LEARNER SUPPORT CENTRES

A Meeting of the said committee was held on 09.04.2026 at 11:00 a.m. under the Chairmanship of Dr. Arun Guleria, Associate Professor, English, CDOE in Room No. 316 to discuss about the strategies to strengthen the Learner Support Centres created by the ICDEOL, Himachal Pradesh University at various Government Colleges/Institutes of Himachal Pradesh. The following members were present in the meeting:-

At the beginning, the Chairman welcomed all the members present in the meeting thereafter placed the agenda/item for discussion before the committee members to discuss and propose strategies for enhancing the effectiveness of Learner Support Centres (LSC's) affiliated with the Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla. After due deliberations, following discussion took place:-

1. That CDOE/ICDEOL operates six LSCs across Himachal Pradesh namely Vallabh Govt. College Mandi, MLSM College Sundernagar, Distt. Mandi, NSCB Memorial College Hamirpur, GC Rampur, GC Nahan and H. P. University Regional Centre Dharamshala, Distt. Kangra. These centres play a crucial role in providing academic assistance, counseling, and support services to distance learners enrolled in Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode.

Key Improvement Strategies discussed:-

(i) It was decided in the Meeting by all the attendees that regular training sessions for LSC staff are essential. These sessions should help staff improve their skills in advising, counseling, and supporting distance learners. The training should focus on important areas like understanding the special needs of ODL learners, designing effective instruction, and using technology in education.

(ii) The attendees highlighted the need to ensure that each LSC is well-equipped with necessary resources such as study materials, books, online tools, and technology. They also suggested setting up dedicated study areas with computers and internet access to support effective learning.

(a) It was decided in meeting that Study material must be provided by CDOE to LSC's so that students can easily extract study material also from there.

(b) In an institute where the LSC are located there must be free access of library of the institute for CDOE students.

(c) The Library of Learner Support Centres must have separate cupboards or almirahs where students can receive CDOE books for study.

(iii) A strong communication system between LSCs, the Regional Centre, and the ICDEOL headquarters was suggested to ensure timely sharing of information and feedback. It was also considered important to create a well-organized feedback system to gather learners' opinions and improve services.

(iv) The attendees talked about the importance of working with local communities, schools, and organizations to spread awareness about LSC services. They suggested organizing outreach programs and using local media to promote the LSC effectively.

(v) Integrating technology to improve support services and simplify administrative tasks at LSCs was seen as important. The attendees recommended options like online counseling sessions, interactive learning tools, and digital communication platforms.

(vi) In the meeting, it was decided that employees at these centers would take charge on a rotational basis for a period of two to three years.

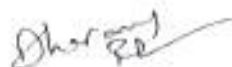
(vii) The need for a flexible ICT-based monitoring system to oversee the performance and quality of LSCs was highlighted. It was considered essential to conduct regular quality checks and take corrective measures to maintain compliance with established norms and guidelines.

The meeting ended with an agreement that implementing the proposed strategies would help CDOE/ICDEOL improve its LSCs. These measures aim to better support distance learners in Himachal Pradesh and greatly enhance the quality and effectiveness of ODL programs provided by H.P. University, Shimla.
