ABOUT THE RESEARCH METHODOLOGY WORKSHOP

OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP

The prime objective of the 6-Day Research Methodology Workshop in Humanities and Commerce is to enhance participants' understanding and application of advanced research methodologies. The workshop aims to provide practical skills, theoretical insights, and hands-on training to enable participants to design, conduct, and analyse Humanities and commerce based research related problems effectively. Specifically, the core objective of the workshop is to equip the research scholars and faculty members with a set of skills and potentialities to undertake the research very effectively in the disciplines of Humanities and commerce and to turn completed research into publishable material of high

BRIEF SUMMARY OF COURSE CONTENT

The course will be conducted in both lecture and interactive mode. In addition to the interactive classroom lectures the participants will also be introduced how to use different software and also to use selected statistical packages like MS-Excel and/or SPSS.

The contents of the course are:

- 1) Meaning, Objectives & Types of Social Science Research, Research Approaches, Problem identification and formulations of Research Question
- 2) Research Design, Selection of research topic, Review of Literature
- 3) Hypothesis Formulation and Test of Significance
- 4) Data Collection Methods

- 5) Analysis of data and Testing of Hypothesis using excel and SPSS software
- 6) Academic Writing, Papers for Journals, Preparation of Reports
- 7) Ethics in Academic Writing, Methods for Avoiding Plagiarism
- 8) Research Proposal, writing a research proposal, Use of ICT in commerce and Social Science Research etc.

The resource persons from different parts of country representing the leading institutions/universities will deliver the expertise in the workshop.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

All registered Faculty members/PG/Ph.D./PDF Scholars in recognized Indian university/research institute from any branch of Social Sciences and faculty of Commerce and Management may send their application for this Research Methodology Workshop. Selected candidates would be informed 15 days in advance of commencing the workshop.

INTAKE

The maximum intake for the workshop shall be 100 seats. The selection committee will select the participants for the workshop based on **first come-first serve**. Notification for selected candidates will be communicated through the registered email/ at university website. Attendance for all the sessions is mandatory or otherwise the certificate shall not be issued
