All the Chairpersons/Directors of the teaching departments are therefore requested that all admitted students should fill the undertaking form online and advised to ensure strict compliance with the UGC Anti Ragging Regulations and adopt effective measures to prevent, prohibit and eliminate ragging in all its forms. The online Undertaking which is available on the UGC designated web site i.e. www.antiragging.in.

Further, all the Chairpersons/Directors are also requested to provide the information regarding Anti Ragging Departmental Committee to the office of the Undersigned and comply with the instructions/guidelines provided in the enclosed letter received from UGC.

Any student found involved in ragging will be punished appropriately which may include:

1. Expulsion from the University/Institution.
2. Suspension from the classes.
3. Fine with a public apology.
4. Withholding scholarships or other benefits.
5. Debarring from the representation in events.
6. Suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess.
7. Legal proceedings under criminal law shall be initiated.

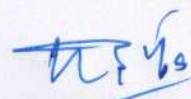

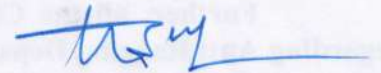

Subject: Strict Implementation of UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions

The University Grants Commission (UGC), in pursuance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, notified the **UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009**. The Regulations are available at www.ugc.gov.in and www.antiragging.in.

All Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) are advised to ensure strict compliance with the UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations and adopt effective measures to prevent, prohibit, and eliminate ragging in all its forms.

Institutions shall, inter alia, ensure:

- Constitution and effective functioning of anti-ragging bodies as prescribed under the Regulations.
- Display of 24x7 Toll Free Number, **1800-180-5522**, anti-ragging posters and publicity materials at prominent locations.
- Submission of anti-ragging undertakings by students and parents through www.antiragging.in.
- Conduct of awareness, counselling, orientation, and sensitization programmes.
- Vigilance in hostels and other vulnerable areas.
- Prompt redressal of complaints, protection of complainants, and timely reporting of cases.
- Immediate registration of FIRs and disciplinary action wherever a prima facie case of ragging is established.

All institutions are requested to accord the highest priority to anti-ragging measures, maintain zero tolerance towards ragging, and ensure compliance by affiliated colleges under their jurisdiction.
