1. INTRODUCTION

1. The Himachal Pradesh University will conduct an **All India Special Entrance Test for admission to unfilled seats in M.CH (CTVS) - SUPER SPECIALITY COURSE -2015** in Indira Gandhi Medical College & Hospital, Shimla on behalf of Government of Himachal Pradesh (Department of Medical Education and Research) in accordance with the provisions contained in the Ordinance 14.15 of the First Ordinance of the Himachal Pradesh University (as amended from time to time) as also in accordance with the Policy Programmes, Rules and Regulations framed for the same by the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh from time to time.
2. The Special Entrance Test will be conducted for two unfilled seats in **M.CH. (CTVS)** Course for Academic Session 2015-2018 starting from September, 2015 in Indira Gandhi Govt. Medical College and Hospital, Shimla for which ONLINE Application forms from the eligible candidates are invited **w.e.f. 21.08.2015 to 10.09.2015** through H.P. University Websites i.e. www.hpuniv.in.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR M.Ch. (CTVS) COURSES

- i. Out of total number of seats, 50% seats will be filled-up from Bonafide Himachali candidates and In-Service candidates of Himachal Pradesh 50% seats will be filled-up on all India level basis in order of merit.
- ii. The candidate must be an Indian National.
- iii. The candidate must have passed MBBS and have MS in General Surgery or its equivalent degree recognized by the Medical Council of India.
- iv. The candidate must be registered with the Central/State Medical Registration Council.
- v. The candidates who have passed MS General Surgery in 2015 shall be eligible only if they produce a passing out certificate at the time of counselling.
- vi. There will be no reservation of seats for any category or group.
- vii. The candidate must satisfy himself/herself of their eligibility before applying.
- viii. Admission to selected candidates shall be subject to verification of eligibility testimonials by the appropriate authority.
- ix. The eligibility conditions regarding mandatory period of service (area-wise) in respect of in-service candidates appointed through Rogi Kalyan Samitites will be as under:-

- x. The upper age limit as on 1st July 2015 for direct group candidates shall be 40 years and for sponsored (GDO In-service) candidates will be 45 years.
- xi. Incomplete application-form will be rejected. Photograph should be coloured without goggles & cap, Identifiable and recent i.e. with in three month (May, June & July) bearing name and date.

Note: Ineligible candidate(s) need not to apply. The candidate(s) found ineligible at any stage shall have no claim for admission or continuation of M.Ch. course even if he/she qualifies in the Entrance Test.

xiv. There will be separate merit list for Himachali bonafide and open merit candidates (specialty-wise). In case of non availability of Himachali bonafide candidate, seats will be filled-up from open category candidates in order of merit and vice versa.

2.2. QUALIFICATION & OTHER CONDITIONS/REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

- (i) The candidate must have passed M.S. General Surgery and its equivalent degrees duly recognized by the Medical Council of India provided the candidate who have appeared in the said course /examinations and the result of which has not yet been declared may also apply subject to the conditions that they will produce the degree at the time of Counselling.
- (ii) The upper age limit for the direct candidates will be 40 years as on 1st July, 2015, provided however, in case of In-service GDO's candidates, the upper age limit will be 45 years as on 1st July 2015.
- (iii) The candidate must have registered with the Central or State Medical Council.

- (iv) The In-service candidates are required to submit their computer generated application form through proper channel or must attach 'No objection Certificate' from their Employer along with application form so as to reach the University on or before the last date for submission of ONLINE Computer Generated Application form which has been fixed as 14.09.2015.

3. ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND DETAIL OF ENTRANCE THEORY- CUM- PRACTICAL/ CLINICAL EXAMINATION, FOR ADMISSION/COUNSELLING TO M.CH (CTVS) COURSE.

1. The admission will be made on merit to be determined on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the Entrance Theory Examination plus the marks obtained in the subsequent Practical/Clinical Examination to be held on the dates notified in the Prospectus.
2. The Entrance Theory Examination shall consist of one paper of 80 multiple choice questions of one marks each (MCQ Type) as per details given hereunder:

M. CH (CTVS):-

Part - A : 40 Questions of one marks each in the subject of Cardiothoracic Vascular Surgery.

Part –B : 40 Questions of one marks each in the subject of General Surgery.

(Note : Both parts i.e. Part A and Part B are compulsory to all.)

3. **There will be No negative marking in the Entrance Theory Examination.**
4. The candidate obtaining a minimum of 35 marks in the Entrance Theory examination will only be called for Practical / Clinical Examination of 20 marks to be held at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla as per schedule notified in the Prospectus. Total Number of candidates to be called for Practical/Clinical examination will be restricted to 5 (five) times the number of seats available in M.Ch Course as per merit of marks obtained in Theory Entrance Examination. However, in case of tie for the last position all candidates with same marks will be called for Practical/Clinical Examination. The Names and Roll Numbers of the candidates called for Practical /Clinical Examination will be displayed on the Notice Board of the University as also in the **Website of the University i.e. www.hpuniv.in** and the **Website of Director Medical Education & Research i.e. www.hp.gov.in/hpdmer** and **Website of Indira Gandhi Medical College i.e. www.igmcshimla.org** on the scheduled date as per the prospectus. The candidates called for Interview are advised to report for Practical/Clinical Examination as per schedule without waiting for receipt of formal letter for the same. The marks obtained in Theory Examination will not be displayed/ notified and will be kept confidential by the University till the awards of Practical/Clinical Examination are received from the Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla.
5. The Final Merit list based on aggregate of marks obtained both in Theory Entrance Examination and in Practical/Clinical Examination will be prepared course wise and will be notified by the Controller of Examinations, H.P. University along with complete result of Entrance Theory examination on the Notice Board of the University, **University Website i.e. www.hpuniv.in** Website of **Director Medical Education & Research Website i.e. www.hp.gov.in/hpdmer** and **Website of Indira Gandhi Medical College www.igmcshimla.org** as also released to the leading Newspapers. The Controller of Examinations will forward the Final Merit list indicating the marks obtained in Theory Entrance Examination as well as in Practical/ Clinical Examination to the Principal, Indira Gandhi Medical College and Director Medical Education & Research for completing the admission process.
6. On the basis of merit list, the candidates will be called for Interview-cum-Counselling as per the schedule provided in the Prospectus by the Counselling

Committee (headed by the Director Medical Education & Research) to be appointed by the Department of Medical Education & Research, Govt. of H.P. The number of candidates called for Interview-cum-Counselling will be 3 (three) times the number of seats available in each course provided the candidate has obtained a minimum of 50 marks in the aggregate of Theory Entrance Examination plus Practical/ Clinical Examination. In case of tie, the following procedure will be adopted to resolve the tie in order of preference.

- i) Higher marks obtained by the candidates in the Theory Entrance Test.
- ii) Higher % of marks obtained by the candidate in MS examination.
- iii) Higher % of marks obtained in MBBS Examination.
- iv) In case the tie still persist the candidate older in age will be given preference.

7. As per direction of the Medical Council of India the allotment of seats shall be done through Counselling on merit basis. Therefore, the candidates called for counseling are required to appear before the Counselling Committee without fail as per schedule given in the prospectus. No formal communication will be issued either by the University or the Principal, Indira Gandhi Medical College/ Director Medical Education & Research for Counselling. The final eligibility, allotment of seats to the candidates will be made by the Counselling Committee on the basis of merit after verification of original documents including required certificates etc.

8. The seat allotment letters to the selected candidates will be issued by the Principal, IGMC, Shimla. The selected candidates will have to appear for medical fitness examination to be conducted by the Medical Board on the date(s) to be intimated in the seat allotment letters. Thereafter, the candidates are required to deposit the requisite fee in the Medical College as per the schedule along with attested copies of the following documents:-

- i) High School Certificate for verification of Date of Birth.
- ii) Marks sheets of all the Professional MBBS Examination.
- iii) Internship Completion Certificate.
- iv) MBBS and MS Degrees.
- v) Permanent registration certificate from Medical Council of India/State Medical Council.
- vi) Relieving Certificate from the Employer (if employed)
- vii) Admit Card
- viii) Attempt certificate of MS examination.

9. (1) At the time of joining the course, original educational and other documents of the candidates be retained by the Principal, Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla.

(2) After joining the course, the selected candidate can leave the course/seats by the 18th Sept. 2015 on account of his/her selection elsewhere as the case may be and fee deposited by him /her will not be refunded in any case. In the event of leaving the course after 30.9.2015(i.e. in midsession) entire fee of the course will be charged from him/her or else his/ her original certificate /documents will not be released by the Principal, Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla.

Important Steps

(A) **Before proceeding to apply, please ensure that you have:**

(i) **Scanned copy of candidate's recent photograph with following specifications.**

- Photograph must be a passport size color picture.
- Photograph must be taken in full face view directly facing the camera.
- Photograph should have no shadows and red eyes.
- Maximum size **50 kb**.
- Photo format should be jpg. only.

(B) Create an email account if you already don't have one.

(C) You must give a correct mobile number in basic details. If you don't have mobile number, please enter your guardian's mobile number for any further information in this regard.

(D) The fee for applying to ONLINE admission forms to M.Ch. (CTVS) courses is Rs. 5000/- for all the categories.

(E) PROCEDURE FOR FILLING UP ONLINE APPLICATION FORM FOR M.Ch. (CTVS) Special Entrance Test - 2015.

1. Click on "**Register Now**" to create a new account. Once the new account is created online system *will generate the unique application form number*. Candidates are advised to *note down the application form number for all future references*.
2. After account creation, click **login** to complete the Entrance Examination application online. Online Entrance Application form has following subsequent information.
 - Fee Payment Form
 - Basic Details
 - Upload Applicant Photo
 - Filled Form View Page Confirmation Button with Edit Option.
 - Filled Form Downloaded Page in pdf format.
3. Candidate's are required to fill their information in above mentioned web pages. All mandatory fields are marked with red star.
4. Upload photo and then press upload Photograph button. Photo uploaded should be as **per specifications and size listed in step (A)**.

5. To save the data, please click on '**Continue and Save**' button at the bottom of each screen before proceeding further.

1. Steps for making Application Fees Payment

- a) Once you click on the text "**CLICK HERE FOR FEE PAYMENT**" new window of **SBI-Collect** will be open on your screen in which you have to complete the following steps for making the payment:

Step 4

Enter all the details of payment as per the fields given on the present screen, all these fields are mandatory to fill for making the Application fee payment. *While entering the Form No. & Mobile No. be ONE HUNDRED percent sure that you are entering the right form no. which was being allotted to you while doing registration on the H.P. University website & right Mobile no. which is already provided on the HPU Website while registration process.* If you have entered the wrong form number or Mobile No., your payment will not be confirmed on the H.P. University website.

Step 5

Once you **Confirm** the 'payment details', a new window will appear on your screen in which three modes of payment are there i.e 1) **Net Banking** 2) **Card Payment** (By Using Debit/Credit Card) 3) **Other Payment modes in which Challan is generated** and the applicant has to take the print out of that Challan to the nearest SBI Branch for depositing the Cash. After depositing the Cash, the bank will issue the receipt/ Journal No. on the Challan. In case of Net Banking and Card Payment, e-receipt will be generated on the website only in pdf format. Applicants are directed to take print out of that e-receipt and retained for his/her record purpose also.

7. After depositing the fee in the bank, candidates can continue to fill up the ONLINE application form and then uploading the photograph on the website. Thereafter, candidates have to confirm the payment by clicking on the payment confirmation button. If the payment is not confirmed wait at least for *12 hours* after making the payment to complete the Application Form. If after 12 hours of depositing the fee payment is not confirmed, please contact on 0177-2831655 or 0177-2833582. Candidates must ensure that the print out of the ONLINE application form will only be generated, if the candidates payments are confirmed.
8. Once the payment will be confirmed, Complete Application Form which will be opened on the screen with edit option. Before proceeding further, please make sure that all the fields of the form are filled in correctly in the confirmation screen only then click on the **Submit Button**. **Once the applicant click on the Submit button of his/her application page, he/ she cannot Edit/Change the details entered.**
9. After clicking on '**Submit**' button new window will appear on the Screen displaying full details of the applicant on the pdf format. Take the print out of the application form and then ***attach the photocopy of payment receipt with the print-out of the confirmation copy of the application form.*** You must retain the photocopy of the online application form and the fee receipt for future reference also.

10. Please ensure before sending the print out of the confirmation copy of online application form that:-

- (i) The application bears the signature of applicant at the placed specified.
- (ii) The application form is duly attested by the attesting authority with seal.

11. - **The candidates may, please note that the Admit Cards for the Entrance Test will not be sent By post and the same will be downloaded by the candidates from University website i.e. www.hpuniv.in with effect from 15.09.2015 onwards.**
- *In case, any candidate sends his/her application form to the Officer other than the designated i.e. The Deputy Registrar (Entrance Tests) H.P. University, Shimla-5, the University will not be held responsible for any consequences.*
- It will be the entire responsibility of the applicant to fill up the online application form as well as depositing the prescribed fee by way of computer generated challan in any branch of State Bank of India or by using debit/credit card of any bank within the prescribed period and obtain the print out of the online application form which must reach within the prescribed period in the office of the Deputy Registrar (Entrance Tests) H.P. 4.2 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS INCLUDING INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED IN THE EXAMINATION HALL

1. The candidate(s) are required to submit the computer generated copy of online application form complete in all respect along with all required documents (Listed in the application form) in the office of the **Deputy Registrar (Entrance Tests), Room No. 10, Ground Floor, Administrative Block, H.P. University, Summer Hill, Shimla - 171005 (H.P.)** by due date prescribed in the Prospectus. The application form can be submitted in person or through Registered / Speed Post at the above noted address.
2. The candidate(s) must affixed recent photograph (Coloured/Black & White) of the size of 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm of good quality without cap or goggles. However photo with spectacles are allowed, if being used regularly.
3. The candidate(s) must ensure that all columns of the application form are filled up and all required Document/Certificates have been attached/ tagged with the Computer generated application form before sending/ submitting it to the University.
4. Incomplete admission form and form received after due date will not be entertained.
5. The candidate(s) are informed that in case it is found that he/she has furnished wrong, misleading and incorrect information for seeking admission, strict legal action will be taken against him/her including cancellation of admission, if admitted on the basis of such information.

6. **The candidate(s) are advised to download his/ her admit card/ roll number on the prescribed date i.e. 15.09.2015 onwards from the H.P. University website i.e. www.hpuniv.in.**
7. The candidate(s) will be provided all necessary clarification relating to Entrance Test by the University. In case of any doubt, the candidate can seek the clarification from the office of Deputy Registrar (Entrance Test) either personally or telephonically on Telephone No. 0177-2830891 and 0177-2833588.
8. The Examination Hall for Entrance Test will be opened 30 minutes before the commencement of the test. Candidates are expected to take their seats immediately after the opening of the Examination Hall. If the candidates do not report in time, they are likely to miss some of the general instructions to be announced in the Examination Hall.
9. The candidate must show, on demand, the Admit Card for admission in the Examination Hall. A candidate who does not possess the Admit Card issued by the University shall not be admitted to the Examination Hall under any circumstances by the Centre Superintendent.
10. **Calculators, Slide Rules, Geometry Box, Electronic Digital Watches with facilities of calculators, mobile phones, pagers or any other electronic gadget are not allowed inside the Examination Hall.**
11. **The Candidates will be given question booklet along with answer-sheet ten minutes before the commencement of the test.**
12. The candidate will check and ensure that the Question Booklet contains number of pages as are written on the top of the first page and if any page is missing or misprint, the same be brought immediately to the notice of the Invigilator before writing any thing on Question Booklet.
13. Immediately on receipt of the question booklet the candidates will fill in the required particulars on the cover page of the question Booklet with ball point pen only. They will deal with the booklet when asked by the Invigilator. Also the candidates will fill in the required particulars on the Answer Sheet.
14. The test will start exactly at the time mentioned in the Admit Card and an announcement to this effect will be made by the Invigilator.
15. **During the examination time, the Invigilator will check Admit Card with the Attendance Sheet–cum-Verification Card of each candidate to satisfy himself/herself about the identity of the candidate. Admit Card will be retained by the candidate thereafter. The invigilator will also put his/her signature in the place provided on the Answer sheet, Admit Card and Attendance Sheet – cum-Verification Card.**
16. Use Blue/Black Ball Point Pen only to darken the appropriate circle. Darken only one circle for each entry as the Answer once marked is not liable to be changed.
17. A signal will be given at the beginning of the examination and at the half-time. A signal will also be given before the closing time when the candidate must stop marking the responses.
18. After completing the test each candidate should check again that all the particulars required in the Question Booklet and Answer Sheet have been correctly written and thereafter the Answer Sheet & Question Booklet will be handed over to the Invigilator by the candidate before leaving the examination hall.
19. The Candidate(s) found removing pages from the Question Booklet during the Entrance Test, Impersonation or trying to appear in the counselling through forged means or by producing fabricated/tampered documents will be dealt with as per law.
20. The Admit Card will be retained by the candidates after the Entrance Test is over. Candidates are advised to preserve their Admit Cards in good conditions till Counselling/Admission in Medical College is over.
21. A candidate is admitted in the College on the basis of the merit of the Entrance Test, but at a subsequent time, if it is discovered that he/she had used unfair means practice during the entrance test, the student shall be removed from the College and all the fees and other dues paid shall be confiscated. Further action as warranted against the candidate as per law will also be taken.

5. CONDITIONS OF BOND, STIPEND AND UNDERTAKING ETC.

- (i) Regular Medical Officer (HPHS) and those serving on contract in the Govt. of HP on selection to M.Ch seats will be deemed to be on duty and will carry their existing pay and allowances.
- (ii) Medical Officer serving under RKS will be given permission to apply and participate in the selection process of the M.Ch (CTVS) seats. On selection their service will however, be deemed to be terminated. Such permission will only be granted in event of such Medical Officers having completed the mandatory service as indicated at para 8 (Eligibility and Admission Requirements for M.Ch (CTVS) Course). On admission to these courses, they will be paid stipend as is admissible to Senior Residents.
- (iii) Direct candidates who may not be employed with the Govt. of H.P. will be paid stipend payable to Senior Resident.
- (iv) All Medical Officers including Direct candidates shall have to execute a bond for Rs. 25 lacs and shall be required to serve the State atleast for 7 years after doing M.Ch. (CTVS) This period of 7 years will also include the period of service rendered before joining the M.Ch. (CTVS) as per the bond executed during doing PG Course. In the event of the Medical Officer rescinding on the terms of the bond the State Government shall have the right of recovering the amount of bond money through competent Court of Law and also writing to the MCI for de-registration of Degree.
